Title: Swimmer recognition and financial assistance

Review - annually

Purpose

This policy covers Swimming Wellington's recognition and financial assistance for Wellington Region swimmers who are selected for Swimming New Zealand teams.

Policy

The policy sets out the amount that can be provided to swimmers selected for Swimming NZ teams at each of the Swimming NZ pinnacle levels as a travel subsidy or recognition of achievement. The amounts in this Policy are subject to Swimming Wellington being able to secure third party funding or sponsorship to cover the assistance referred to in this policy (or are otherwise at the Board's discretion).

NB: The meets within each level may vary from year to year at the discretion of Swimming Wellington and SNZ.

SNZ pinnacle meets	Swimming Wellington Financial Assistance/ Support
Level 1 Meets International pinnacle events Includes - Olympic Games FINA World Championships – long course Pan Pacific Championships Commonwealth Games AWD Selection Events 900+ points	\$500 prior to departure and \$500 as a finalist in top 8, upon return
Level 2 Meets Senior Development or Youth Target international events Includes - FINA World Championships – short course Oceania Championships Junior Pan Pacific Championships World Youth Games Youth Olympics World University Games AWD Selection Events 800+ points	20% of user pays component confirmed by SNZ to a maximum of \$1,200
Level 3 Meets International Age Group Includes - Pacific School Games Trans-Tasman Series Australian Youth Olympics Australian Age Groups Australian State Teams Championships	15% of user pays component confirmed by SNZ to a maximum of \$800

Conditions:

1. For Level 2 & 3 meets, Swimming Wellington will reimburse the swimmer on confirmation their payment to Swimming New Zealand has been made.

If Swimming Wellington is successful in securing additional grants or other funding towards the SNZ User Pays component for Level 2 & 3 meets, then Swimming Wellington will pay either the grant or the financial assistance set out above, whichever is the greater.
