

Individual and Relay

How is this form different;

- ⇒ A form is to be used for each competition, not each record at a meet
- ⇒ Complete the top section noting date, Pool, course length and competition name
- ⇒ Date that new record is set
- ⇒ Club registration number **must** be shown alongside swimmers name [**this can be obtained from MM**]
- ⇒ Remember to mark each record as either [P] being a prelim and [F] finals
- ⇒ Remember that if a record is broken in Prelims then Finals each record counts as a separate record
- ⇒ Please ensure that all previous record details are shown
- ⇒ Certification of records; please indicate and sign where applicable
- ⇒ Records **must be lodged within 21 days** of performance to count in accordance with SW Regulation 8 of the constitution

Conditions for a Swimming Wellington/New Zealand records;

- ⇒ All Wellington record applications must adhere to the FINA, SNZ and SW rules.
- ⇒ Regulation 8.5 of the SW constitution states; "Except where electronic timing is used, three separate manual times using electronic watches shall be recorded by three qualified timekeepers." i.e. the chief timekeeper and the three timekeepers in the lane in which the record was achieved **MUST** be qualified by their respective regional associations.
- ⇒ Swimming New Zealand regulation 9.2 states; "New Zealand records will only be accepted when times are recorded by automatic timing or semiautomatic timing in the event of an automatic timing system malfunction..."
- ⇒ Swimming New Zealand regulation 9.10 states; "An application must be received by SNZ within 21 days of the date of the performance, or within 21 days of a competitor/team returning from overseas.
- ⇒ A competitor (Club Team Manager or Race Secretary) may apply for a SW record as long as the application is received by SW within 21 days of the performance and includes the following supporting information:
 - Electronic: a copy of the official meets results, plus the completed Record Application Form signed by the meet Referee.
- ⇒ Information to be certified by the meet referee as above (if possible). If not possible, by the club or regional team manager who attended the event. By signing this application the referee/team manager certifies that they held their respective position at the competition and that all rules of FINA/SNZ/SW pertaining to SW records were fully observed.
